**Shark Program For Kids!
At the Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum on
Monday, July 27 at 11 a.m.**

June 29, 2009 (Provincetown) On July 27 at 11:00 a.m. the Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum (PMPM) will offer a one hour educational program on *The World of Sharks* conducted by educators from the Cape Cod Cooperative Extension Service. Children will examine the world of sharks by viewing models, preserved sharks and /or jaws and a life-sized model of a shark. The program culminates with children making a shark tooth necklace or bracelet to wear for the summer.

The one hour program is for children ages 8 and up, maximum of 15 children per program. Free with admission to the PMPM. Families may wish to plan to spend extra time visiting the museum, climbing the Pilgrim Monument and/or enjoying a picnic lunch on the grounds after the program.
