February 3, 2010 (PROVINCETOWN) Provincetown has been recognized as one of the "dozen distinctive destinations of 2010" by the National Trust for Historic Preservation.

Town Manager Sharon Lynn formally accepted the award this morning at a ceremony in town hall.

The trust says Provincetown was recognized for its history dating back to the pilgrims and its cultural and pioneering arts, including being America's first artists colony.

The National Trust for Historic Preservation picks communities that offer cultural and recreational experiences different from those found at typical vacation destinations.

President Richard Moe calls the outer Cape town an "American gem" that offers visitors the ultimate experience.

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the pilgrim monument's completion.
