**Program for Kids about Camouflaged Creatures!
at the Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum
Monday, July 26 at 11 a.m.**

June 29, 2010 (Provincetown) On July 26 at 11:00 a.m. the Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum (PMPM) will offer a one hour educational program on Camouflaged Creatures conducted by educators from the Cape Cod Cooperative Extension Service. Through observing models and/or live animals, children will understand the survival benefit of camouflage. Children will participate in an activity using this unique adaptation by coloring fish patterns to “camouflage” them.

The one hour program is for children ages 8 and up, maximum of 15 children per program. Free with admission to the PMPM. Families may wish to plan to spend extra time visiting the museum, climbing the Pilgrim Monument and/or enjoying a picnic lunch on the grounds after the program.
